**Shofar: Jewish Music**

The great Jewish poet Berthold Auerbach wrote, “Music washes away from the soul the dust of everyday life.” There is no doubt that throughout our history, musical instruments have helped lift the Jewish neshama to great heights. And yet, many synagogues like Agudath Achim have traditionally prohibited their use. Why is that?

Two thousand years ago the Levites worshipped God through song and prayer and the use of live instruments. In fact there are many midrashim that describe the pure joy our ancestors experienced on the Sabbath as they played the lute and lyre in joyous celebration of God’s greatness.

However, in 70 CE, the Roman Empire destroyed the Temple and Jewish life as we know it changed dramatically. The Rabbis of the Talmudic era ruled that musical instruments should no longer be played on the Sabbath for two reasons. If a string broke, a musician might be tempted to fix it which would desecrate the Sabbath. This is a classic example of a Shvut, a fence around the Torah. In addition, the Sages contended that music was no longer appropriate following the destruction of the Temple as our

nation entered a collective period of mourning.

In the eyes of many modern Rabbis, the period of mourning has ended and we must return to our Jewish roots by reintroducing musical instruments into our services. I find that music not only beautifies the service but also touches a part of us spiritually, where words often fail. It can open a gateway to God for many Jews who struggle with the Hebrew text or are flummoxed by the content found in our ancient liturgy. For this reason, Conservative congregations across the country are trying to enliven and reimagine the prayer experience by using guitars, drums and bass.

J. Shawn Landres is the former director of research for Synagogue 3000, and an advocate for synagogue innovation. In a survey he conducted in both synagogues and mainstream churches, there was an increase in attendance that correlated directly with live music. According to the study, 58% of congregations that always use live percussion in services report that they are growing compared with growth having been reported by only 23% of congregations that never use percussion.

It’s for these reasons that our congregation has decided to create our own musical Shabbat service with live instruments. Change is always hard, but I along with many other members believe that it is the right thing to do. The first ‘Shabbat Musica’ service was kicked off on August 22nd, 2014. Pat Himes and I led the congregation as we experimented with some beautiful new melodies and the sounds of the guitar. We hope you enjoyed this as much as we did, and we look forward to using song and dance to remove the dust of everyday life and reconnect with our Jewish souls.

Dear Fellow Members of Agudath Achim Synagogue,

I am humbled but enormously thankful for the honor that Agudath Achim has bestowed upon me at the recent annual meeting in May. Having been named “Honorary Life President of Agudath Achim Synagogue” is an honor that I did not expect. Including me with only five other individuals who have received this special honor in our synagogue’s 129 year history is something that I will always cherish.

Serving our synagogue has been a pleasure and an honor and I extend my deepest gratitude to Agudath Achim for allowing me to be a part of our extended synagogue family and share in the life cycles of our membership.

Barbara and I have made a wonderful life in Altoona through our participation with Agudath Achim. Agudath Achim has provided us with a warm, friendly, and caring environment where we are able to enjoy our holidays and customs with so many friends. We have spent almost every High Holiday service in Agudath Achim for the past 38 years while our parents and siblings were observing the multitude of holidays at Temple Israel in Wilkes-Barre, PA, where we both grew up and attended Hebrew School and weekly Shabbat Services. That was our home until we affiliated with Agudath Achim, Altoona.

I have had the pleasure to work with so many individuals and Spiritual Leaders during the years and I have benefitted from our experiences together. Rabbi M. Herbert Berger, Of Blessed Memory, comes to mind today because he loved his congregation, his role as our Rabbi, his friends in our congregation and he loved Judaism. Rabbi Berger taught me the importance of helping to build a synagogue that we can all call home.

Thank you again for presenting me with this lofty honor.

My kids are my first go-to when trying to come up with the theme based design for the cover and Tyler's first comment was, "Isn't food like the theme about every other year?"


Truth is--it's not far from the truth. As a people steeped as much in tradition, family values, rituals and symbolism, it is difficult to describe the Jewish faith without an important edible being an integral part of the discussion.

Certainly there are ritual foods. Latkes for Hanukkah, apples and honey for the Rosh Hashanah, challah for Shabbat, harvest foods for Sukkot, hamantashen for Purim, fruits of the trees for Tu b'shvat. Passover, of course, is not only based on specifically what we eat, but the order in which we eat it! We have always been taught we fast on Yom Kippur so that we can focus on prayer and the sincerity of asking forgiveness, but truly to have such an important holiday that does not have a special food associated with it is almost a punishment in itself!

Then we have our vittals that are Jewish foods for any and all times that we love--lox and bagels, knishes, gefilte fish, kreplach, mundel bread, schnecken, borscht, chopped liver, kugel, tzimmes, chicken soup---I could go on (and please pardon the spellings). These foods are common ground at our life cycle events, Oneg Shabbats, and family get togethers and indeed provide a spiritual sustenance common to no other faith.

Most importantly for us as Jews and a people who value our family and connectivity with our Jewish community whom we regard as our extended family--we pride ourselves in handed down and shared recipes not only for our traditional eats but with the relationships with the people who make them. I pay a special homage here to Jordan Bailing and Marv Meisner for the wonderfully special challah making experience they shared with me. We all have many of these moments where we have had the benefit of preparing a "Jewish" food with someone we love who has a specialty and a special way of preparation that you just won't find in a cookbook.

Nosh, pray, love. And repeat. For thousands of years.
